



# Erasmus+ - Key Action 1 - Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

## STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

**Students from all over the world can apply for Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree programmes (EMJMD) scholarships.**

- The scholarships are provided to excellent students worldwide to **cover travel cost, participation costs, insurance and living costs** during the entire duration of the Master course.
- The EM JMD grant will finance a **maximum of 20 student scholarship holders** (i.e. a maximum of 60 student scholarships for the three intakes)





## Eligible students

- For students possessing a diploma that gives access to the **Master degree** studies
- Only for students attending joint programme on **full-time basis**
- A minimum of **75% of the scholarships** are earmarked for candidates from Partner Countries
- Max. 3 scholarship** holders from one country
- Students who have already obtained Erasmus Mundus scholarship in the past are not eligible to apply



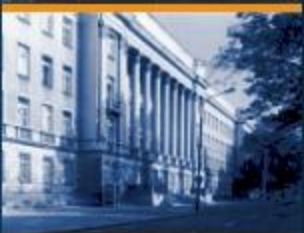
## EMJMD student scholarships

The scholarships are allocated strictly based on the quality of applications. The value of the scholarship package will depend on student background:

- **Programme countries** refers to all European Union countries plus Macedonia, Turkey, Iceland, Norway and Lichtenstein.
- **Partner countries** are those that do not fall into the definition of “programme countries”.



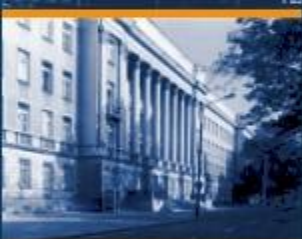
EMJMD student scholarships - AMOUNTS



Budget category	Students from Program countries	Students from Partner countries
<b>Contribution to participants cost including tuition fees and insurance</b>	<b>4500 € / year</b>	<b>9000 € / year</b>
<b>Contribution to Travel and installation costs</b>	<b>1000 € / year</b>	<b>2000 € / year + 1000 €</b> (less than 4000 km from the EMJMD coordinating HEI)  <b>3000 € / year + 1000 €</b> (4000 km or more from the EMJMD coordinating HEI)
<b>Contribution to Subsistence costs</b>	<b>1000 € / month</b> for entire duration of EMJMD study programme (24 months max.)	







## REMARKS

- Contribution to subsistence costs **will not be given** to the scholarship holders for the EMJMD periods (study/research/placement/thesis preparation) spent in their country of residence,
- nor to scholarship holders from a Partner Country for the EMJMD periods exceeding one trimester (i.e. 3 months or the equivalent of 15 ECTS credits) spent in any Partner Country.
- **Provisions on all financial aspects** will be included in the **Student Agreement** signed between the coordinating institution and the enrolled students

- \* In the summer of each year new selected Erasmus Mundus programmes will be added to the list





## When and where to apply for EMJMD student scholarships?

- \* Students should **contact directly the universities coordinating the course** for information on how to apply, requirements and deadlines for the scholarships.
- \* Most consortia will require applications to be submitted **between October and January**, for courses starting the following academic year.
